The ideal candidate will have a natural drive to work with different types of machinery and make parts that fully meet all required specifications. Job Requirements:

- Checks output for quality assurance and documents or discards defects.
- Identifies need for and performs machine maintenance and minor repairs.
- Maintains a safe and clean workstation and area.
- Willingness to be cross trained in other tasks pertaining to the manufacturing process and various departments as needed.
- Takes an active role in manufacturing production planning.
- Contributes to team effort by accomplishing related tasks as needed.
- Work with other staff team members in a positive way on a day-to-day basis.
- Knowledge of Cattle Industry/Livestock Handling Equipment Preferred.
- Perform additional duties as assigned by supervisor or designated staff person.
